Bruce Dickter Memorial Soccer Scholarship



LYSA—Longwood Soccer Club is proud to announce that applications are now being accepted for the Annual **Bruce Dickter Memorial Soccer Scholarship**. This scholarship program is open to all qualifying seniors who meet or exceed the required criteria. The Bruce Dickter Memorial Soccer Scholarship is made possible due to the efforts of many volunteers who organize and run the Longwood Soccer Club. Of course this scholarship would not be possible without the person for whom this scholarship is named after – Bruce Dickter. Bruce is the founding father of LYSA Soccer and the reason many of us are still involved in youth soccer today. Bruce was taken from us far too early, but the memory of his dedication to the game and the children who play it will be with us forever.

Proceeds from Longwood Soccer Club's registrations and fundraisers are used for the distribution of scholarships. In the past years, we have given out over \$200,000 in scholarships. This year, the Bruce Dickter Memorial Soccer Scholarship Committee anticipates a disbursement of approximately **\$5,000** in scholarship funds.

The Soccer Scholarships will be open to all those who have or had an affiliation with the LYSA Soccer Program. The applicant must be a student in "good standing" with their respective High School and plan to attend a college of higher education. Each student must submit the mandatory documents, including the application form (attached), a summary of their student activity, letters of recommendation, an essay discussing what you have learned from soccer and how you will apply that, as well as a copy of your High School transcript.

All applications will be kept confidential and will only be reviewed by the Bruce Dickter Soccer Scholarship Committee. The Committee will be comprised of our volunteers and it is the Committee's policy to review all applicants fairly and without bias or prejudice.

All applications must be received on or before the end of April . Any application received afterwards will not be accepted or considered. Incomplete applications will be disqualified, no exceptions. The Scholarship recipients will be announced by the Longwood Soccer Club Executive Board. **(date & time to be determined)**.

To be eligible for the Bruce Dickter Memorial Soccer Scholarship the following items must be submitted with this application. Failure to submit any of the required documents will disqualify you from the process.

1. The Student must have an affiliation, past or present, with LYSA Soccer. Please provide dates.
2. The Student must be in good standing with the School District they are graduating from.
3. The Student must plan to continue their education by attending a school of "higher education".
4. The following documentations must be submitted and attached to this application form:
 - a. Official High School Transcript from your Guidance Office indicating your cumulative grade point average.
 - b. Letter(s) of recommendation from Teacher(s) in your School District and/or a Community Leader(s).
 - c. A second letter of recommendation from an official of LYSA Soccer, describing how you assisted or participated in the program.
 - d. Write an essay of 400 to 600 words with the following theme: **"Please explain metaphorically how your experience with LYSA or Longwood School soccer has had an effect on who you are today and what you hope to become in the future."**
5. This Application along with your transcript, letters of recommendation, your essay and a summary of student activities must be received in its entirety by **April 30th**.
